Hi there. When most of you read this you will not know that it is being written several weeks earlier. I have mentioned before that this article is written in advance to accommodate the lead-time of many chapter Newsletter editors.

On July 31st I was returning from the memorial service for Andrea Maguire, our District Web Master. At about 4:30 PM while traveling Westbound on the I-210 Freeway in the San Gabriel Valley I saw a small shiny object in front of me in the Diamond Lane. I tried to swerve and miss it but my rear tire hit whatever it was.

I decided to move over to the right shoulder to examine my tires. Upon reaching the lane closest to the shoulder I realized that my rear tire was losing air pressure fast. After the rear tire lurched from left to right about 3 times I lost control. The wing and I came to rest on the right shoulder. My injuries will heal and JBJ Cycles will repair my bike.

If you are going to be in a hospital in this area Huntington Memorial is a good one. But, as nice as it is and looks it doesn't make for a good vacation.

Remember if your tire encounters something on the highway that could puncture it get over to a safe place and check your tires ASAP.

I want to THANK all the many people that have e-mailed, called and sent cards wishing me well. Most of all I want to THANK Pat for all of her care, patience and love during this time of recovery.

After learning the details about this trip I was ready to do it.

4 days – what to pack? Oh no problem this time as I only have to pack for myself. The first time on the bike and on the road without my husband and maybe with people I don't know – except Bob.

Friday the August 9 arrived quickly. The bike has got fresh oil, the windshield was clean, tires had the right pressure (well the rear tire was not the newest but will hold up this tour), the gas tank was full and the MP3 player had 20 hours of music.

Friday morning 5:30 AM I looked in the frustrated face of a husband, said “ciao,” and headed to the famous Rudgear Road to meet with Bob Hole. Besides me, Bill Andrews decided to come along and as well Brian Roberts a Long Distance Rider who was riding the first 500 miles with us.

This 20 miles to Walnut Creek I was only thinking, “What am I doing here?” But when we left the parking lot and I put the music through my head I was only excited and with the words of my husband in mind, “I am proud of you doing this,” I set the cruise control for the upcoming 2300 miles.

That first day we stopped in Gerlach a LD – riders mecca. There at Bruno's Restaurant and Saloon we had lunch and as I was told the specialty is homemade ravioli (as usual I didn't eat it but it was looking really good).

After lunch we did some “off roading” on Guru Lane. The place where a true LD rider has to visit once and where some of them have their memorial stones too. After 50 miles Brian separated from us. Our final destination for this day was Burns, OR where we stayed overnight.

Saturday's ride began at 6:30 and we rode to Kennewick, WA where we met two former chapter members (with an orange 1800 with a lot of safety chrome) for lunch. From there the three of us rode to the Coulee Dam through some gorgeous scenery. Unfortunately, we didn't find any available rooms in a motel within 30 miles of the dam and so we had to go on to Wenatchee. I have a really good reason to come back one time because I Would like to see the laser show which they are doing every day at night.

And on the way to Wenatchee the funniest (afterwards) part of the whole trip happened. But I won't tell it here again because if you attended the last meeting you know everything about it.

On the Sunday ride Bob lead us along the Columbia River into the North Cascades NP. Here finally was the road for the motorcycle. Twisties through high mountain range. Unfortunately, the rear tire on the 1800 didn't look too good. As well I discovered some metal stuff in it, so with this in mind I had to slow down and everyone was quite worried. But at least I was able to enjoy the road up to the Cascades. I would have gone on alone so Bob and Bill could go to Mt. Rainier and Mt. Saint Helens, but Bob canceled this because of my tire and would not let me go on alone .

On Monday it was only driving home on the freeway and looking at the tire every gas stop and water stop. This was necessary because we had to drive partly in around 114° heat.

At least I want to thank Bob Hole for giving me the opportunity for a 4 day trip with scenery, only sunshine, fun and in one place a special adventure and good lesson for all of us.

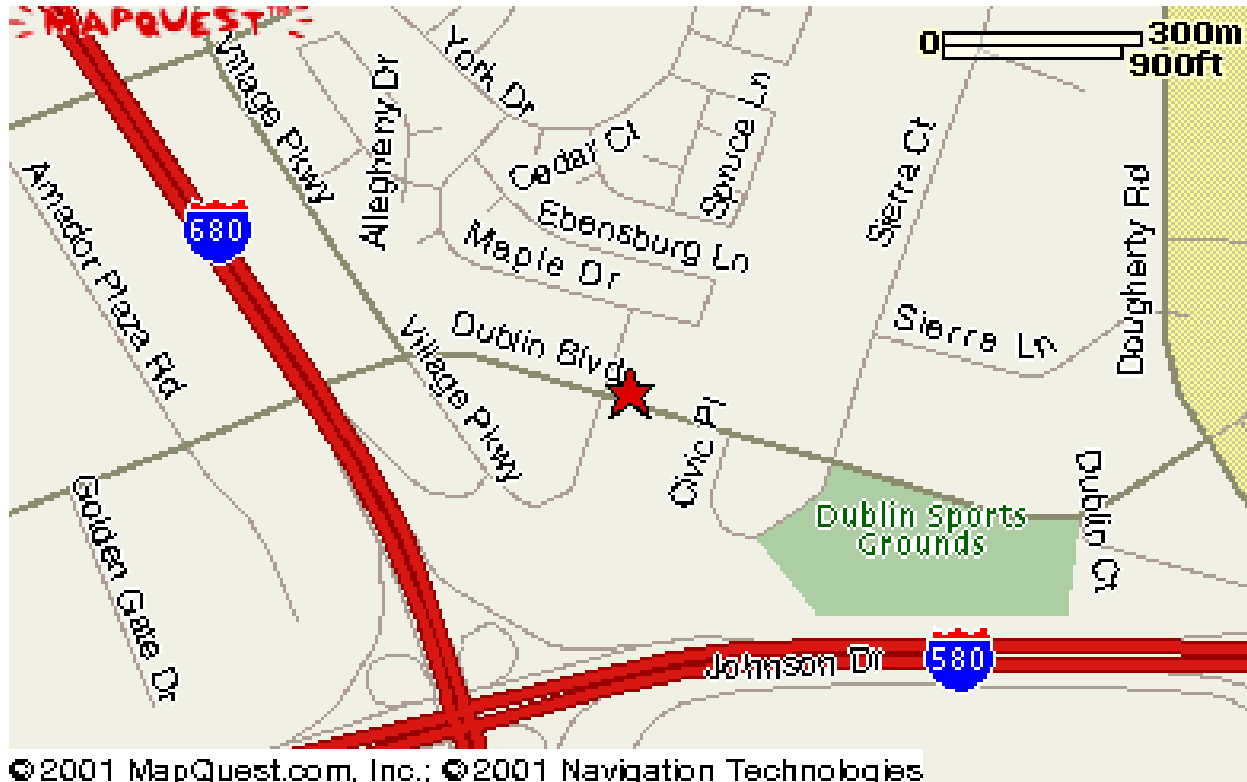




Chapter CA2Q meets on the 3rd Saturday of each month at 8:30 am.

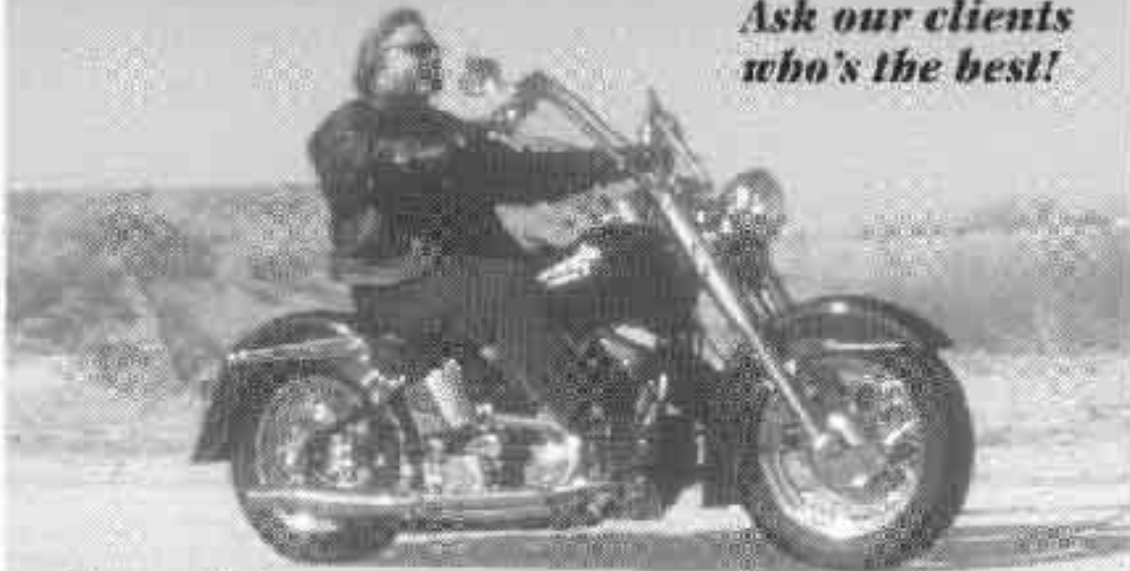
