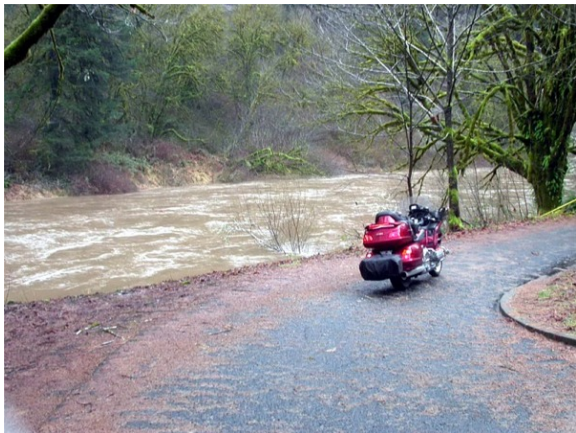

U.S. 93 from Kingman, AZ to Wells, NV is a very pretty and scenic route over Hoover Dam, the Great Basin Highway, a Pony Express Station, etc. I-80 from Salt Lake City, UT is through some very pretty areas of the Ruby Mountain range. I-80 from Reno has several mountain peaks visible in the distance making for a very scenic and enjoyable ride, too.

Some attractions in the Elko area are: Northeastern Nevada Museum, California Trail, Newmont Mining Company tours, Western Folk Life Center, 35 restaurants, Elko Junction Shopping Center and East End Mall, Wal-Mart, as well as downtown shopping.

There are several scenic rides available within a 100-mile radius from Elko. They include Owyhee, NV, Lamoille Canyon, Harrison Pass, Angel Lake, Metropolis, NV, Tuscarora, NV, and I-80 east to Wells, NV and then U.S. Hwy 93 north from Wells, NV toward Twin Falls, ID. These are more than enough to keep you busy during the three-day celebration.

Remember, this is your Region. This rally is for you, the member, and it will only be successful if you are there. This is a combined Nevada District Rally and Region “F” Rally. Come see what changes we have made—we think you will be happy with them. We made these improvements because you asked for a different agenda. We need your support to make this rally a success.

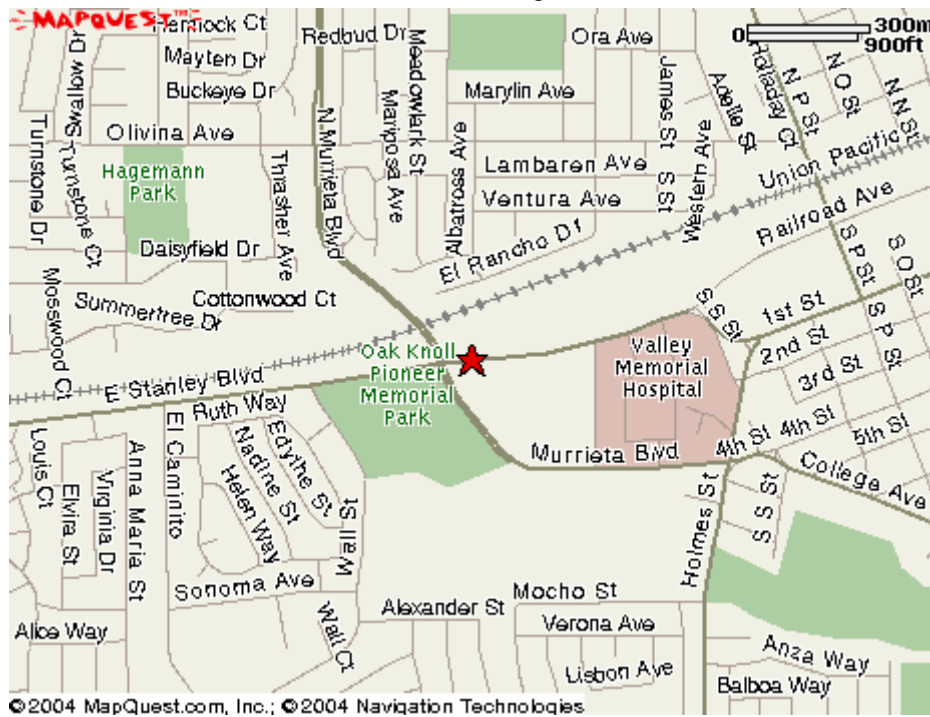
