Directions to Pereira Deer Camp

1. From the Pleasanton/Dublin area, take *680 North*
2. Take *Highway 24* toward Orinda
3. Take *Orinda exit....1st exit*, veering right toward Orinda Village.
4. When you leave off ramp and enter road, **stay on road... do not enter Orinda Village.**
5. Travel approximately 2 miles. You will pass the Sports Field. Turn **right** on *Bear Creek Road*.
6. Stay on *Bear Creek Road*. You will be on it several miles until it ends. When you reach what appears to be a “Y”. Stay to the **right** (Hampton Road is to the left) *Bear Creek Rd continues to the right. Bear Creek Road ends at a stop sign. You have come to Alhambra Valley Road.*
7. **Go straight. Road has now become Pereira Road.**
8. Continue about a half mile. **Left** where you see the sign "*Private Road*".
9. Go about .1 of a mile or so. Make *Left on Rancho de Maria*.
10. Continue on that *Rancho de Maria*. You will come to gate or gates ... (Gates will not be locked ... just lift chain over). **Please close gates behind you...cattle are in the pasture.**
11. Continue on dirt road until you reach *Pereira Deer Camp*. You cannot miss it.

As you travel through Bear Creek Road....watch out for deer!!!!

There is no cell reception in this area.

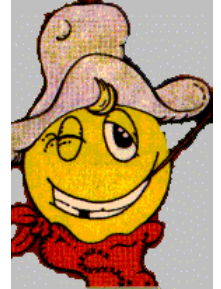

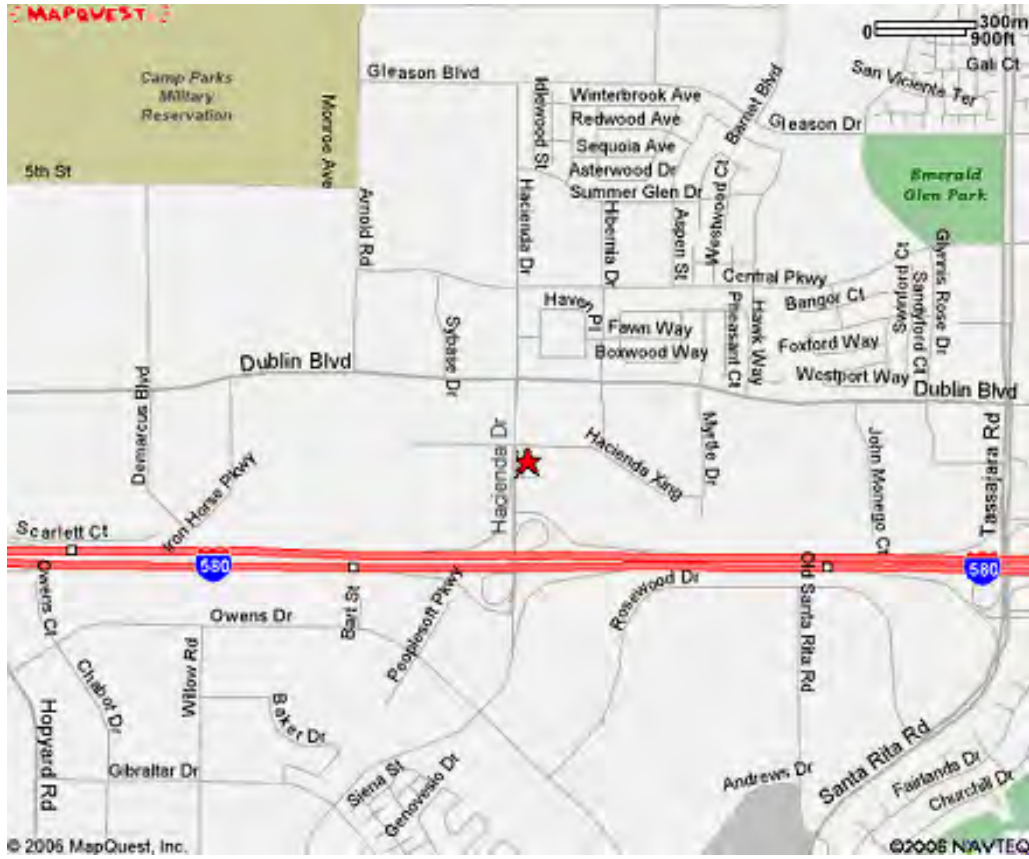
