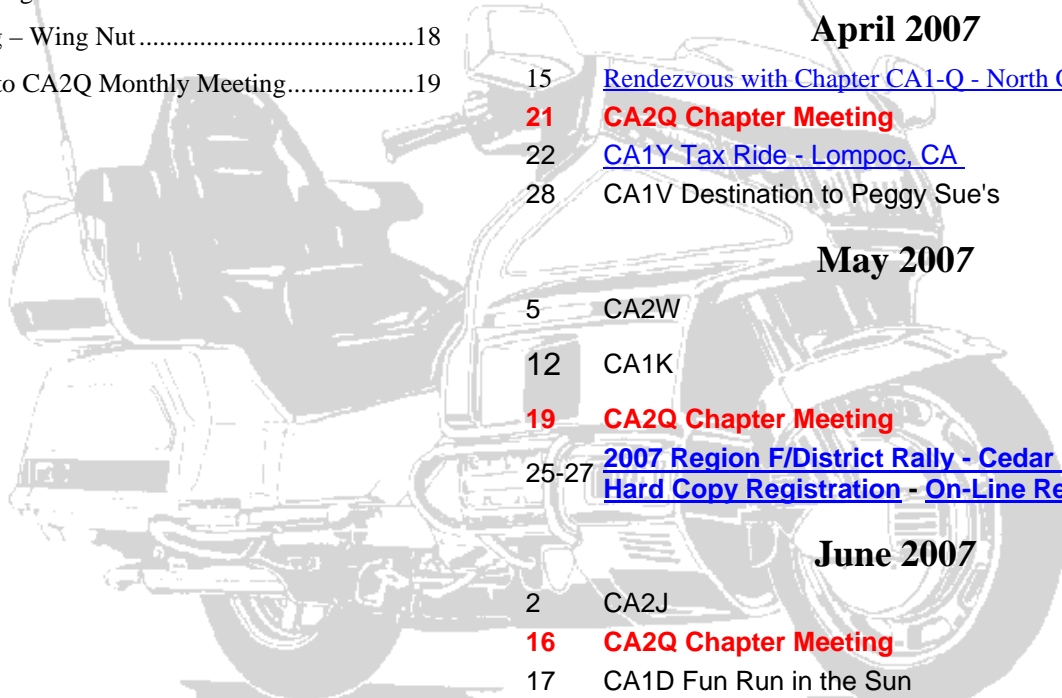

We will just need to coordinate our chapter visits and make sure the CD or ACD of the Chapter that is visited signs off the score sheet. Also remember that we will be seeing a lot of visitors to our chapter meetings by other chapters

How to accumulate game pieces and points:

- You can travel either on two wheels or four wheels (three wheels is ok too)

- Every chapter is given mileage points (just mileage – not number of member times miles) (mileage is one way)
- Have your score sheet signed off by the CD or ACD of the chapter you visited
- Create a table centerpiece for the District Rally using all the game pieces your chapter collected

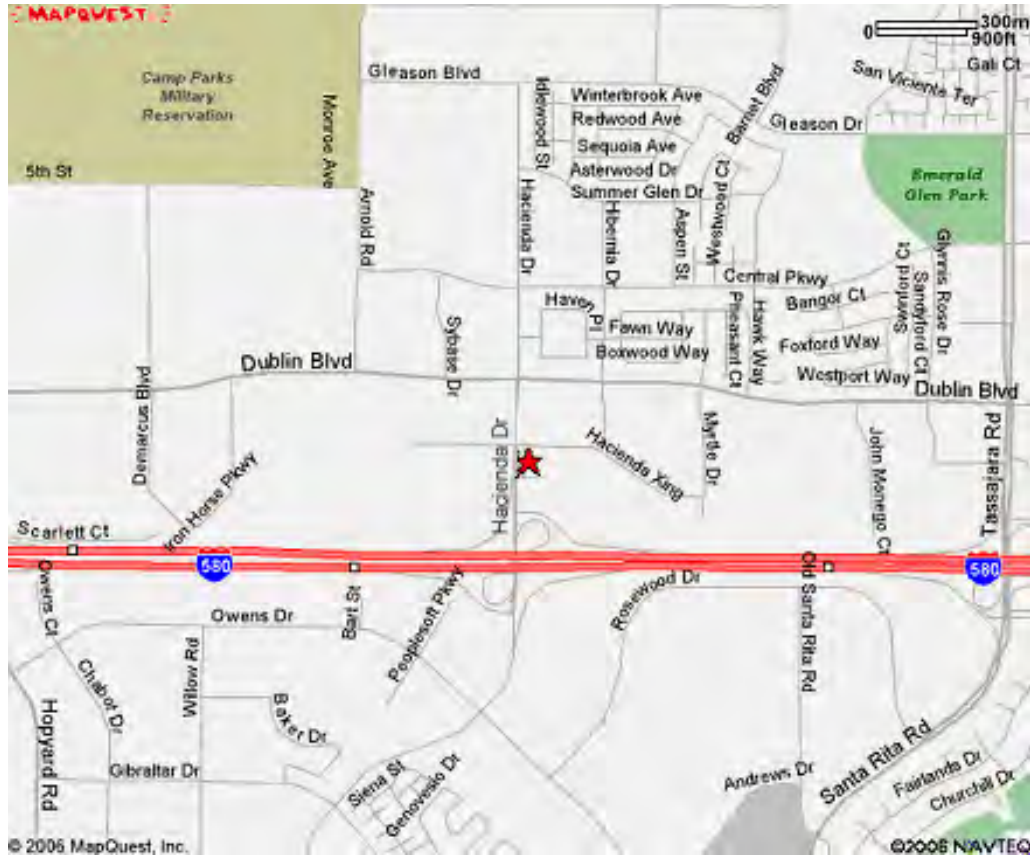
