Safety always must come first!!!

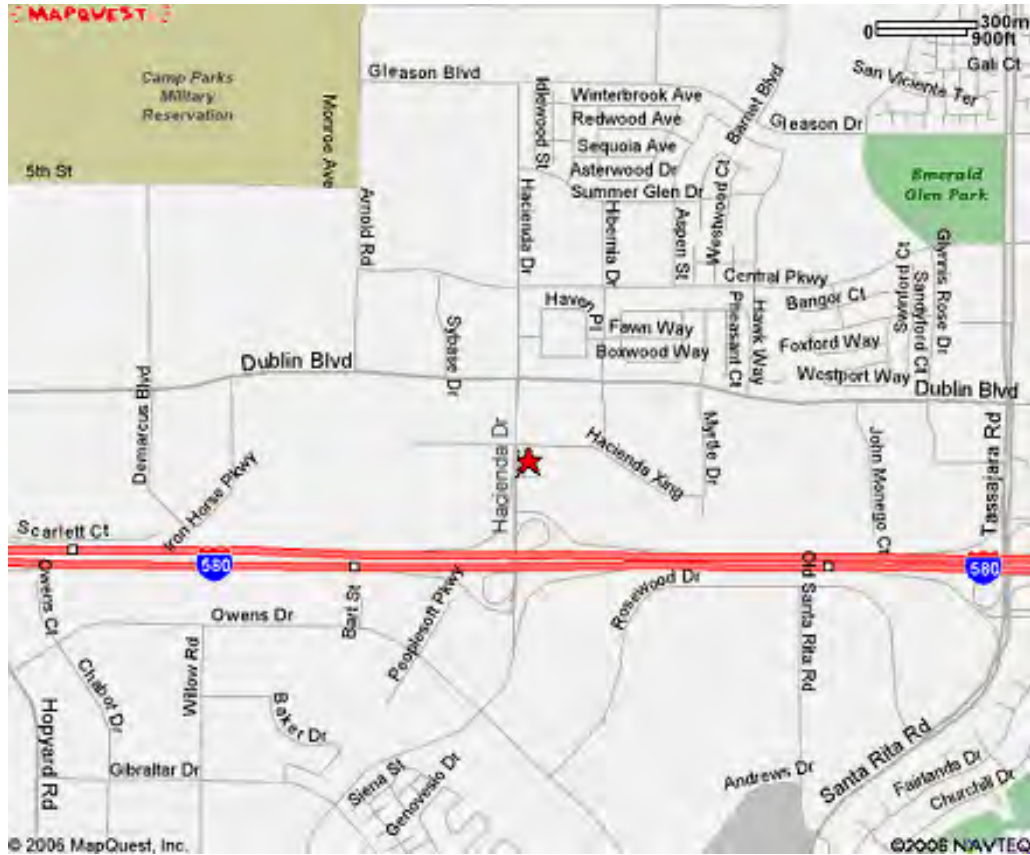
