To not to take anything or anyone for granted, and maybe even tell our friends and especially our family how much we appreciate them (I hope that doesn't come across as being too dramatic or sappy (as some might say), but hopefully you understand my point).

This is also a time my thoughts are with those riders who are all participating in the Iron Butt Rally back east. ## ACD Message

Our District had a GWRRA leadership training seminar based on the Horizon Program on the weekend of August 10<sup>th</sup>. It was a five module course that included Team Building, Expectations, Effective Meetings and Gatherings, Communications & Public Speaking Techniques and Officer-Couple Partnership. They also added a pre-program personality assessment. Dale thought it would be an excellent opportunity for Shirley and I and we agreed.

Because of work, Shirley and I couldn't make it for the Friday night social to kick off the program. So, we got up at 2-am Saturday and drove down for the 8-am start.

We agreed to share the driving switching off every hour. I started off and kindly gave her an extra 20 minutes of sleep before pulling over for her hour. I think I was short changed. I "know" I only closed my eyes for no more than 15 minutes before I was awakened for my turn. I'm sure the clock was manipulated.

We made it to the DoubleTree hotel at Bakersfield in plenty of time. There were approximately thirty folks attending the class. Anita Alkire, Crystal Rush and Rick Dyer led the course presentations. And in usual GWRRA fashion, the gathering started off with a little fun. We were given a listing of names in three groups. Based on your own name initials, you looked for your corresponding "Stage" name. You knew it wasn't going to be a typical "Tom, Dick or Jane".

My handle for the weekend was "Snickle Dippin Doodle" and Shirley was "Dorky Dippin Doodle". In comparison, ours were pretty normal sounding names. I don't think I can repeat some of the more original combination others had but it was a good morning chuckle.

The most eye opening portion of the course was the pre-program "Personality Analysis". The test had thirty two paired statements. Depending on how strongly you relate to one statement over the other, you represent it by assigning values to each (3-2, 4-1 or 5-0). You then go through several steps of totaling your values to come up with your four personality codes. There are eight personality codes being analyzed. The eight are paired to determine your dominant four.

The eight codes are:

Introversion (I)	Sensing (S)	Thinking (T)	Judging (J)
Extraversion (E)	Intuition (N)	Feeling (F)	Perceiving (P)

There are sixteen possible combinations. And with each, an assessment or a "personality style inventory" is provided along with names of famous individuals of similar character.

As skeptical as I can be, I had to admit to some accuracy in how I was categorized. But I may also be influenced by the fact these "personality style inventories" are all slanted in the positive. But then again, how productive would it be to point out the negative? Keep in mind too; although the analysis determines a dominant personality category over another, it doesn't mean one is better or lesser than the other. It just means a different approach.

Okay.... I suppose you're wondering what did Shirley and I ended up with??

Shirley was determined to be an "ESFJ":

*For ESFJs the dominant quality in their lives is an active and intense caring about people and a strong desire to bring harmony into their relationships. ESFJs bring an aura of warmth to all that they do, and they naturally move into action to help others, to organize the world around them, and to get things done. Sensing orients their feeling to current facts and realities, and thus gives their feeling a hands-on pragmatic quality. ESFJs take their work seriously and believe others should do so as well.*

*Famous ESFJs: George Washington, Dolley Madison*

I was determined an "INTP":

*For INTPs the driving force in their lives is to understand whatever phenomenon is the focus of their attention. They want to make sense of the world – as a concept-and they often enjoy opportunities to be creative. INTPs are logical, analytical, and detached in their approach to the world; they naturally question and critique ideas and events as they strive for understanding. INTPs usually have little need to control the outer world, or to bring order to it, and they often appear very flexible and adaptable in their lifestyle.*

*Famous INTPs: Albert Einstein, Marie Curie*

Anita had said they would be sending a soft copy of the personality self-assessment to all the attendees. I think our chapter members would enjoy a little insight into their own personality. If we don't get the soft copy, I think Shirley and I can scan the test and distribute to our members.

The rest of the training program was equally informative. They went through each module's philosophy and explained theories and techniques in a simple manner that anyone can practice. It's an excellent program that's open to all members. Not just Officers. I believe anyone taking the course will benefit not only for themselves but for their chapter as well. "The more you understand how the process works, the easier it is to get involved."

I particularly enjoyed the team building exercise which included role playing. It was a great way for this natural introvert to open up and get to know the folks on his team.

In this exercise, teams were assigned scenes to play out based on a typical Chapter happening. Each team is free to determine the details and decide each member's role (I was Chapter Educator). The assignment was given to us at the end of the day Saturday with our performance scheduled after the final module Sunday.

Most of the teams got together after class to come up with their approach for their assignment. Some like my team had each member come up with their own lines. Well... this isn't something I'm familiar with so it took me a little more time to come up with my lines (I've always hated homework).

Next morning I think a lot of us were still rehearsing our roles in our heads. I know I was and I think Shirley was too. As the final module was being presented, which happened to be "Officer-Couple Partnership", they talked about how a harmonious relationship was essential for the Officer-couple to be successful, that's when it dawned on Shirley what day it was (August 12<sup>th</sup>) and started giggling. The woman sitting next to her asked what was so funny. As she told her, the woman stood up and raised her hand stating to everyone that there's a couple here on their anniversary that had not even said happy anniversary to each other. Boy... 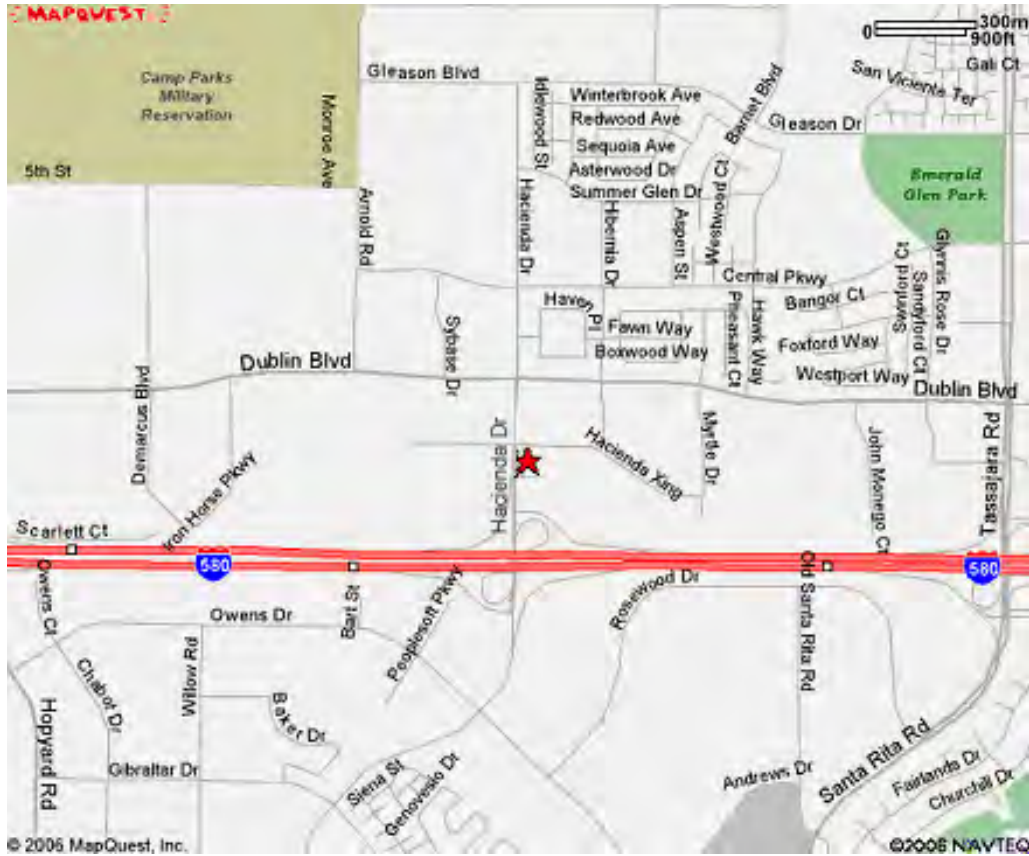
